**Appointment Joint Village/Town Planning Board Member**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees appoint Joseph Colombo to the Joint Village/Town Planning Board thru 5/31/2014 to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Bill Davis. The motion was made by Trustee Essler, seconded by Trustee Gray. Carried 5-0.

**Annual Appointment Local Registrar, Deputy Local Registrar**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees appoint Lori Gray as Local Registrar and Cynthia Essler as Deputy Local Registrar for the year 2014. The motion was made by Trustee Cox, seconded by Trustee Essler. Carried 5-0.

**Executive Session**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees enter Executive Session at 6:02 PM for the purpose of discussing appointments and promotions of particular personnel. The motion was made by Mayor Morgan, seconded by Trustee Cox. Carried 5-0.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees exit Executive Session at 7:01 PM. The motion was made by Mayor Morgan, seconded by Trustee Gray. Carried 5-0.

**Appointment Chief Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees, in anticipation of the retirement of Ronald Macomber, appoint Markus Hugi as Chief Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator effective January 1, 2014 at a base rate of \$18.00 per hour, with a yearly Chief Operator Stipend of \$2,800 prorated for the remainder of the 2013-2014 fiscal year. The motion was made by Trustee Essler, seconded by Trustee Gray. Carried 5-0.

**Seasonal Worker**

Clerk Gray stated that the Board needed to begin a different thought process in regards to the employment of seasonal workers for the DPW in effort to reduce potential liabilities regarding unemployment claims and the changes in healthcare laws. She recommended that a permanent part-time employee be hired, based on the hours currently utilized for a seasonal worker. The average would be approximately 20 hours per week for 52 weeks. During winter months the hours could be decreased, with hours increased during spring and fall, not to exceed 29 hours per week. 30 hours per week is considered full-time employment according to healthcare reform for which the Village would be required to provide healthcare benefits. Korey Gillen has filed for unemployment. Potential cost to the Village for the first seven weeks of unemployment claimed would be \$131.00 per week, equaling 13 hours of hourly wages per week.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees offer Korey Gillen a permanent part-time position as Laborer for 15 hours per week, effective immediately, at his current rate of \$10.00 per hour. The motion was made by Trustee Essler, seconded by Trustee Gray. Carried 5-0.

**Other Business**

Trustee Essler suggested that a Special Executive Session be held during a Regular Board Meeting for the purpose of hashing some things out amongst employees.

**Adjournment**

With no further business to be discussed, the motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Essler at 7:49 P.M., seconded by Trustee Gray. Carried 5-0.
