ATTENTION VILLAGE OF NUNDA RESIDENTS

This is a friendly reminder to all village residents regarding residential trash pickup and placement of garbage for pickup within the Village of Nunda. As per the NYS 2020 Property Maintenance code. Sec. 308.3 “Every occupant of a structure shall dispose of garbage in a clean sanitary manner by placing such garbage in an approved garbage disposal facility or approved garbage containers.”

Acceptable and approved containers shall be of metal or plastic and shall be rodent-, insect- and leak-proof as well as watertight. Containers must have close-fitting covers and be fully closed at all times. Check with your refuse collecting company- they may provide suitable containers. Open top drums, buckets, bins, and boxes are neither suitable nor approved.

All trash bags and garbage must be placed in approved containers to be set out for collection. Containers must have closed and or tightly fitting lids. Overflowing cans, loose trash, trash bags, cardboard boxes placed directly on the curb or street side for collection may be subject to violation of the NYS property maintenance code as well as applicable Village laws.

By order of the Mayor of the Village of Nunda garbage containers may be placed at the curb no more than 24 hours prior to scheduled collection and must be removed from the curb by the end of the collection day.

Approved Containers shall be supplied by owner/residents in sufficient number to hold ALL collectible wastes / recyclables which may accumulate. Such containers must not be kept in any front or exterior side yard as per Local Law 1 of 2008 section 9-B of the village of Nunda.
