Approval of Minutes

A. March 31, 2025

MOTION was made by Trustee Piper to accept the minutes as presented, discussed, and reviewed, seconded by Trustee Mann. Carried 5-0.

New Business

A. Parking on Village Streets

MOTION was made by Trustee Davis, Seconded by Trustee Mann to make the following change to Local Law #2 of 2013, to no parking in the Mall Parking Lot nor any streets or highways (including curb lawns and driveway aprons) in the Village between 11 PM and 6 AM from November 1st to April 1st. Carried 5-0

B. Interceptive Dance Workshop

MOTION was made by Mayor Morgan, Seconded by Trustee Piper for GVCA and LIV CO Grow to use the upstairs of 1 Mill Street as an alternative site or venue for their interpretive dance workshop. Carried 5-0.

C. May 10, 2025 – Annual Spring Clean-Up Day

MOTION was made by Deputy Mayor Snyder, Seconded by Trustee Piper to share the cost and service with the Town of Nunda. Carried 5-0

D. Excavation for Sewer Connection

MOTION was made by Mayor Morgan, Seconded by Trustee Davis to approve the application for a permit to facilitate the drilling of a sewer install for Account #1859 located on Route 408. Carried 5-0.

1. Fair Street between Mill Street and Massachusetts
 2. South Church St between East and Mass
 3. All of Church Street
 4. Mall Parking lot
 5. Municipal Parking Lot

MOTION was made by Deputy Mayor Snyder, Seconded by Trustee Davis to move forward with all paving *except* the Municipal lot. The funds for the municipal parking lot paving will be used for the Mall Parking lot paving and any remaining funds will be carried over to the following year for the Municipal Lot to be finished. Carried 5-0
