

Local Law #2 of 2017 – Regulating Parking in the Village of Nunda

Section 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT

The purpose of this Local Law shall be to promote the safety and general welfare of the Village of Nunda, including the protection and preservation of the peace and good order by adopting and enforcing certain regulations, rights and privileges of the residents of the Village of Nunda and by imposing restrictions upon parking within the Village limits.

Section 2. DEFINITIONS

All terms within this Local Law shall have the same definition as they are defined in the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.

Section 3. REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

(a) No automobile or motor vehicle shall park at an angle except in the space or spaces marked for angle parking.

(b) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked closer than ten (10) feet to an intersection or a fire hydrant.

(c) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in front of a driveway or alley.

(d) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked except between the lines of the marked parking places in areas where marked parking places exist.

(e) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked double except as necessary to load or unload said vehicle.

(f) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked on any crosswalk.

(g) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in the spaces marked "No Parking".

(h) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked with the left side of said vehicle next to the curb, except on one-way streets.

(i) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked longer than the time limit specified in areas so marked by signage.

(j) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be abandoned on village streets or in parking areas.

(k) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be left unattended with the keys in the ignition or with the motor operating.

(l) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in a fire lane.

(m) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in a handicapped zone without a handicap sticker or decal.

(n) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in such a manner as to obstruct the traffic lane.

(o) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in a space marked "No Standing ANYTIME".

(p) No automobile or motor vehicle shall be parked in a space marked "No Stopping ANYTIME".

Section 5. PENALTIES

(a) A violation of this Local Law shall be deemed an offense against and the within this Local Law and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50 and not less than \$10. Each separate offense shall constitute a separate additional violation.

(b) Any person found to have violated this Local Law shall also be responsible for the cost of towing and storage of a vehicle removed from the streets or parking areas of the Village.

(c) Any fine or penalty hereunder not paid within ten (10) days of the due date shall be doubled, and if not paid within ten (10) days thereafter, be referred to the Village Justice Court for further legal action as provided under the laws of the State of New York.

Section 6. SEPARABILITY

The invalidity of any work, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or part of this Local Law shall not invalidate any other work, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or part thereof.

Section 7. REPEAL OF PRIOR LAWS

Any and all existing ordinances, or other Local Laws pertaining to parking in the Village of Nunda which are inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 8. WHEN EFFECTIVE

The provision of this Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in the State of New York.
